Sandhia Rajan is the program manager for Partnership for Prevention's tobacco control activities through the ActionToQuit initiative. She manages the ActionToQuit State Grant Program, supports ActionToQuit's communication efforts by managing the website, listerv, webinars and podcasts, and performs other duties to develop and promote sound tobacco control policies.

Before coming to Partnership, she worked in the Health Promotion Department at the US Naval Hospital, Okinawa, Japan. Her work involved surveying the staff and beneficiary population, determining health risks, and developing programs to prevent disease. Tobacco cessation was the department's priority due to the high prevalence of tobacco use in the U.S military. She also worked as a research associate at the Henry M. Jackson Foundation in Rockville, Md., providing laboratory support to the Vaccine Research and Development Program.

Sandhia holds a bachelor of science from Drexel University in Bioscience and Biotechnology and a master of public health from Johns Hopkins University.
